

ARTIPHONIE

The Artiphonie project consists in developing a mobile application for children with language impairment.

The idea was created by Estelle GILLET-PERRET, a speech therapist from Grenoble university Hospital.

The aim of the application is to allow children to do daily practice at home on their pronunciation in addition to regular sessions with their speech therapist. Artiphonie is a free and collaborative application.



Speech therapist can choose a list of words specific for each child depending on their weaknesses.

They can also get statistics on each child to help them improve.



Children can use the application to learn and train using mini-games on every sound of the French language and on specific words chosen by the specialist. The activities help them, using the Borel-Maisonny method



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
